

The Volleyball BC Hall of Fame honours athletes, teams, coaches, officials, and builders who have had a significant impact on volleyball in British Columbia. Inductees exemplify the best in the history of the sport in our province.

Selection Process

- Nominations for induction in the following calendar year are accepted until September 1.
- Any individual or association may submit a nomination with the following exceptions:
 - A current Member of the Volleyball BC Hall of Fame Selection Committee may submit a nomination, but if the committee member submits a nomination, she or he may not vote on that nomination or be part of the discussion surrounding the nominee.
 - A member of the Volleyball BC Board of Directors may submit a nomination, but if the Director submits a nomination, she or he may not vote on that nomination if and when it is brought to the Board of Directors for approval.
- Aside from the Team category, nominations will be accepted for individuals only. Family members or
 colleagues who worked together closely are eligible for induction within the same year or in subsequent years.
 However, each nominee will be considered separately on the basis of her or his own individual merit, and if
 selected will be inducted individually.
- Each nomination is eligible for three (3) consecutive years. If at the end of three (3) consecutive years of eligibility, a nomination has not been selected for induction, the nomination must sit inactive for a period of one (1) year after which the nomination can be resubmitted.
- All nominations will be considered at an initial Awards Committee meeting in October. Depending on the
 outcome of that process, further information on the nomination may be required.
- The final selection process will take place in October and the names will be released to the media in November.

Selection Criteria

Coach Category

Eligibility:

- A coach who has made a significant contribution to the sport of volleyball in British Columbia through consistent excellence, leadership, and commitment over an extended period of time.
- Must have coached in a league, club, or system recognized by Volleyball BC

Accomplishments Considered:

The selection committee will evaluate nominees based on a combination of the following factors. Achievements should demonstrate both competitive excellence and lasting impact on athletes and the volleyball community:

- Team Success:
 - Sustained high-level performance and achievement of teams under the nominee's guidance (e.g., provincial, national, or international success; consistent medal finishes; championship titles).
- Athlete Development:
 - Evidence of developing individual athletes who achieve future success at the provincial, national, or international level.
 - Creating environments that promote long-term athlete growth, learning, and character development.





Selection Criteria (Continued)

Coach Category

Accomplishments Considered:

- Coaching Awards & Recognition:
 - Formal recognition at the club, provincial, national, or international level (e.g., Coach of the Year awards, professional accolades).
- Integrity & Leadership:
 - o Demonstrated ethical conduct, mentorship, and role-modelling.
 - o Contributions to a positive sport culture, athlete well-being, and respect for the game.
- Commitment to the Sport:
 - Significant years of service as a coach in BC.
 - Involvement in Volleyball BC programs (e.g., Team BC, club, provincial team development, clinics, coaching mentorship).
 - Active support of the growth of volleyball at multiple levels (grassroots to high performance).
- Professional Development:
 - Ongoing pursuit of coaching education and certification.
 - Engagement in learning opportunities to advance personal coaching practice and elevate standards in the community.

Nomination Instructions

Complete the Nomination Form and submit electronically or in person along with supporting documentation, including one (1) letter describing the achievements and merits of the nominee as they related to selection criteria for the relevant category (maximum 3 pages), two to five (2-5) letters of support from relevant members of the volleyball community, and a brief biography of the nominee.

Successful nominations will also be asked to provide at least one high resolution photograph of the inductee.

In order to help the Selection Committee, please attach supporting documentation in order to verify the merits of the candidate. Supporting material included:

Completed nomination form

One (1) letter describing the achievements and merits of the nominee as they related to selection criteria for the relevant category (maximum 3 pages);

Two to five (2-5) letters of support from relevant members of the volleyball community (maximum 2 pages each);

Brief biography of the individual with information such as birthplace, when and where training was received, background information not captured in the questions, or a brief profile of the team outlining athletes, coach and trainers (maximum 1 page); and

(OPTIONAL) Any other supporting material that may help (newspaper clippings, tournament results etc.).
